IT'S EASY TO FIND

Our system of groomed trails, and access points to non-motorized areas, have become a staple of the local ski community. Access is either a quick commute, or a beautiful drive away, so take advantage of our miles of groomed trails to help you find the snow, space, silence and delight of winter.

DIRECTIONS TO GREEN CANYON:

From Logan, go to the intersection of 1900 North and 1600 East. From there, head east (on 1900 North) about a mile, where you'll find an excellent parking area with restroom facilities.

DIRECTIONS TO BEAVER BOTTOMS:

From Logan, travel east on highway 89 about 25 miles to the Beaver Mountain turn off (.8 miles past milepost 486). Turn left onto Road 243 and go about 1/2 mile, where you'll find parking for both Beaver Bottoms groomed track, and the Sink Hollow trail, to your right.

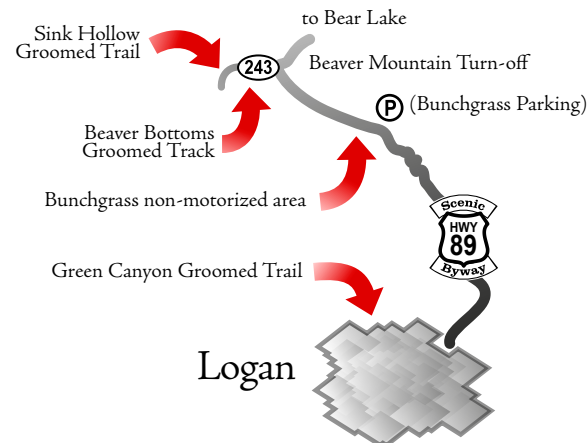
DIRECTIONS TO BUNCHGRASS:

From Logan, head east on highway 89 about 20 miles. Just past the turnoff for Tony Grove Lake, near milepost 481, you'll find ample roadside parking on the right.

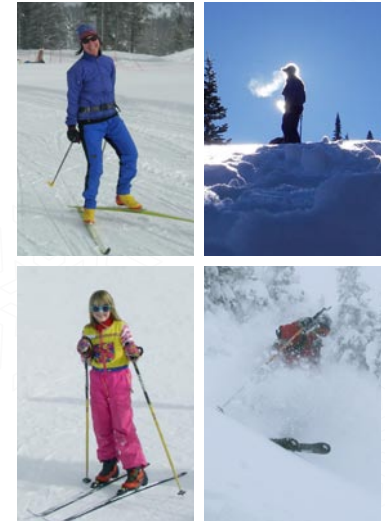

Once you've realized the immense joys of Nordic skiing, snowshoeing, or skiing and snowboarding the backcountry, you've probably realized that simply having access to lands and areas prized for these activities is as crucial as snow.

For nearly a decade Nordic United has worked to make our public lands more accessible to non-motorized winter recreational activities. We provide groomed trails for Nordic skiing and snowshoeing, and we participate in public meetings and land management decisions involving non-motorized winter recreation.

Nordic United has something to offer all ages and experience levels, and can provide advice, referral, and instruction on all types of non-motorized winter recreation. If you're new to outdoor winter recreation come try one of our skate ski clinics, or grab a pair



of snowshoes and hit a groomed trail at Sink Hollow, or the non-motorized Bunchgrass area. And if you're already an expert, come test yourself in one of our ski races, cross-country ski up to the Green Canyon Yurt, or ask one of our knowledgeable members about the many possible backcountry trails in the Logan area mountains.

Nordic United sponsors numerous events and workshops throughout the winter season. Our Citizen's Race Series features categories for all levels of skill and technique and culminates in March with

the Ullr Chase. A nod towards earlier ages, this Nordic ski race symbolizes the retreat of Ullr, the Norse God of skis, back into the north with the approach of spring. The Ullr Chase offers categories for all ages and experience levels, and draws participants from all over the west.

We work closely with the Utah State University Campus Recreation Department and the US Forest Service in the grooming and maintenance of our excellent system of local ski trails.



Nordic United is the voice of quiet, human powered winter recreation. And so long as our voice is heard, the wide white spaces and unbroken silence of winter can remain intact.

WHAT WE PROVIDE:

KIDS SKI PROGRAMS

GenXC is the Nordic United sponsored Kids ski program. It introduces cross-country skiing to the next generation (kids 8-13). The program is a series of weekly classes which make use of our system of groomed trails. The goal of the program is to provide a safe and challenging environment to introduce young skiers to the sport with an emphasis on fun and fitness. The classes are based on a time-tested program developed in Norway.

SKATE-SKIING CLINICS

This program advances participants' skills in the techniques of skate skiing, with groups and sessions tailored to suit all levels of skill or experience.

CITIZEN'S RACE SERIES

Our race series spans the entire ski season, providing events to challenge all levels of skill. Held at the excellent Beaver Bottoms groomed trails, this series of events ends with the Ullr Chase.
